

'WILD ASANA' CAMEL COWL KNITTING PATTERN

Materials: Beyond-human being fiber yarn (whatever animal, weight, and color you like), knitting needles (any size), yarn needle or crochet hook

Skill: Easy (relatively)

Abbreviations:

St: stitch

K: knit

P: purl

Measurements: To be determined :)

Gauge: This is the point at which 'real knitters' would knit a sample swatch to verify that based on tension, yarn weight, and needle size the finished piece will be the 'right size.' I've never done this :)

Instructions:

1. Cast on as many sts as you want. Enjoy the feeling of the yarn in your fingers.
2. First row: K each st. Think about the animal who used to wear the fiber you now hold in your hands.
3. Second row: P each st. Think about the human and beyond-human being partnership from which you are creating this something-new.
4. Repeat steps 2 & 3 until piece is the size you want it. Breathe or chant with each st.
5. Cast off.
6. Sew sides together and weave in ends.
7. Wear your cowl. Become camel.
